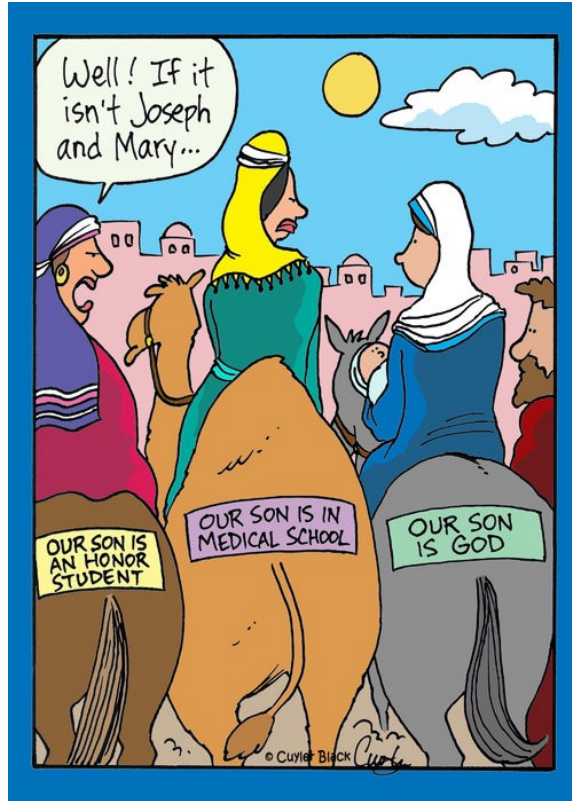

1/2- 1 c. Chopped Walnuts

Place all ingredients, except nuts, in a bowl and blend well. Beat on medium speed 2-3 minutes. Add nuts. Pour into greased and floured Bundt pan and bake for 55 minutes at 325 degrees


