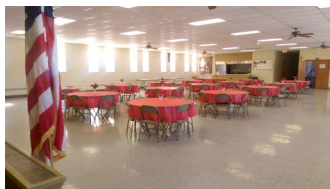


## Parish Hall Now Available for Rent
